




- Point patterns activate and regulate circulation of qi in the entire body – "treating the body as a whole"
- Dr Ni used these
   patterns especially when
   working with the Qi Jing
   Ba Mai

#### Geometric Point Patterns

- Circle
- Figure 8
- Triangle
- Square
- Zig-zag
- Wanzi
- Diamond

#### Circle



Represents life in unity with the Heavens
 (macrocosm) as well as continuous flow of qi within the body
 (microcosm)

#### • Function:

- Gathers Qi in a small area
- Guides Qi to opposite ends
- Circulates Qi through entire body

#### Circle

- For local use SDT shallow needling
- For whole body insert clockwise for women and counterclockwise for men
- To direct Qi down, first needle upper body then lower.
   Reverse if directing Qi up
- Location:
  - Trunk, head, limbs
- Examples:
  - STD around skin lesions, around vaccination injections
  - Hypertensive HA: GB20, LI11, St36, Liv3 (in this order) or 4 gates
  - Prolapsed uterus: Sp3, St36, St13, Du20, Ren4 (in this order)

# Figure 8 - Infinity • Represents the infinite circulation of energy




### Function:


- Invigorates Qi and Blood circulation
- Most powerful pattern for activating Qi circulation in a physiological manner
- Breaks up stagnations

#### Figure 8 - Infinity

- Dr Ni mainly used confluent points. Needle each end of one diagonal first, then continue in figure 8 flow adding midpoint last
- The #5:
  - SW66: "On Earth spirit manifests as Wu Xing and 5 flavors"
    - 5 needles
- Location:
  - 4 limbs with optional midpoint
- Examples:
  - Nausea in pregnancy: PC6, Sp4, Lu5, Sp9, Ren14
  - Tai Yin, Shao Yang: Lu5, Sp9, SJ5, GB41, Ren12

### Triangle






- Represents stability
- Focuses and directs Energy
- Function:
  - Guide stagnation out
  - Guide Qi to a targeted area
  - Both in order to achieve stability

### Triangle

- Location:
  - Trunk, head
- Examples:
  - Sinusitis: LI20, YT or UB2, Du24 or St2, YT
  - Frontal HA: St8, Du20
  - Dysmenorrhea: St25, Ren 3 or Zi Gong, Ren 6
  - Li Dong Yuan's 3 triangles for general tonification (Jeffrey Yuan):
    - Ren 12, St36 MJ
    - Ren 13, PC6 UJ
    - Ren 10, St25 LJ

### Square




- Represents stability and evenness
- Functions:
  - Supplements Qi/Blood
  - Loosens stagnations
  - Both in order to achieve stability

### Square

- Bilateral 4 needles
- Location:
  - Trunk
- Examples:
  - Blood Xu: 4 Flowers UB17, UB19 (moxa)
  - Diarrhea: St25, St27
  - Shao Yin/Mysterious Void: Kid21, Kid11

### Zig Zag




- Directs Energy in one direction while gathering Energy along both sides
- Functions:
  - Guides stagnation out of body

### Zig Zag

- Location:
  - Trunk, head, limbs
- Examples:
  - Right Ovarian cyst (Dr Ni): St13 (L), GB24 (R), St25 (L),
     Ren6, Zi Gong (R), St30 (L), Liv9, Sp9, Sp4 (R)

#### Wanzi



- Dr Ni: Yang descends from Heaven. Yin ascends from Earth both diverted inside a person
- Represents the descent of Life Force from the Heavens into me, integrated into me, and expressed back out
- Functions:
  - Harmonizing Wu Xing,Liu Jing
  - Removes stagnation out of body

#### Wanzi

- Location:
  - Abdomen, limbs
- Examples:
  - Harmonizing Metal and Wood improving blood quality and movement: LI1,3 (R), Ren4, GB37, GB41 (L), Liv4, 8,9 (R), Ren12, Lu4, Lu3 (L)
  - Balancing Wood and Fire getting Fire back into Blood:
     SJ4 (R), Ren12, GB41 (L), Liv8 (R), Ren4, Liv14, PC3 (L)

### Diamond




- Similar to the stable square with a focus in the center
- Functions:
  - Activating, drawing and converging Qi into a targeted area

#### Diamond

Needle in a diamond pattern with central needle last

- Location:
  - Everywhere
- Examples:
  - Tennis elbow: Ashi central needle and around it in diamond pattern approximately 1 cun from center
  - Low back pain: Du3, Du4, Du5, UB23
  - Tian Gu Ba Zhen (Dr Li Shu Ren)


#### Intention and articulation

### Figure 8 and Shao Yang / Jue Yin

- Most powerful pattern for activating Qi circulation in a physiological manner:
  - ShaoYang (Liver Qi stagnation pivot Qi/MF fire inside Blood) and JY blood stagnation
  - Damp accumulation hindering on free flow of Qi
- Xue Fu Zhu Yu Tang
  - Possible Figure 8: PC7, Liv2, LI4, Liv3, Ren3
- Chai Ling Tang
  - Possible Figure 8: Lu5, Sp9, SJ9, GB34, Ren9


### Zig Zag and Yang Ming

- ZZ is opening through
- Tao He Cheng Qi Tang (post partum "insanity")
  - Possible ZZ: Du14, UB14 (L), UB44 (R), UB47 (L), UB52 (R), UB25 (L), (Liv8, UB55, Sp4) R
- Dr Xia's Jia Jian Tong Yu Jian
  - Shan Zha, Xiang Fu, Hong Hua, Wu Yao, Qing Pi, Mu Xiang,
     Ze Lan, Chi Shao, Chuan Niu Xi, Tao Ren
  - Possible ZZ: (LI<sub>3</sub>, Lu<sub>4</sub>, St <sub>18</sub>) L, Liv<sub>14</sub> (R), Ren6, St<sub>28</sub> (L), (Liv<sub>9</sub>, GB<sub>34</sub>, Sp<sub>6</sub>, GB<sub>41</sub>) R
- Gui Zhi Fu Ling Wan
  - In case coming up

#### Wan Zi and the entire circular flow

- Dr Yuning Wu's Zi Shen Tiao Chong Fang modified for the stimulating phase in ART:
  - Entering from Heaven :
    - Bai Zi Ren, Ba Ji Tian
  - Pivoting into me:
    - Chai Hu
  - Rooting in Shao Yin:
    - Ba Ji Tian, Xu Duan, Tu Si Zi
  - Tai Yin:
    - Shan Yao
  - Expressed back out:
    - Gou Qi Zi, Dang Gui, Chuan Xiong, Dan Shen
- Possible Wan Zi acupuncture to harmonize YY, strengthen Kidneys and improve blood flow: (Lu7, Lu1) R, Ren12, (Kid16, 13) L, Liv8 (L), (GB41, Kid 7, Sp6) R, Ren4, (Liv14, Ht 7) L

- ZZ pattern:
  - Lu<sub>4</sub> (R), Lu<sub>1</sub> (L), Liv<sub>1</sub><sub>4</sub> (R), GB<sub>2</sub><sub>6</sub> (L), St<sub>2</sub><sub>8</sub> (R), St<sub>2</sub><sub>9</sub> (L), (St<sub>3</sub><sub>4</sub>, liv<sub>6</sub>, GB<sub>4</sub><sub>1</sub>) R
- GZFLW (12 g each)with added Chuan Niu Xi 12, Ze Lan 12, Yi Mu Cao 30, Xu Duan 12
